Tuesday, **July 21, 2026**, is **PRIMARY ELECTION DAY**, when Arizona voters go to the polls to nominate their political parties' candidates for the General Election. *The mail-in ballots will be sent out to voters on June 24th.* Your Democratic neighbors urge you to review the complete list of **Democratic Primary candidates for State and local government offices**, even though there is no contest in some races.
